
VENUE - Sheraton Porto Hotel & Spa

The city was classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996.

When discovering Porto, you will find many surprises. Besides its welcoming and conservative environment, Porto is also contemporary and artistic. This is shown not only in the streets, architecture, monuments and museums, but also in the terraces, restaurants, leisure and shopping areas.



Traveling to Porto

BY AIR





Arrival Airport:

Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (phone +351 229 432 400), 11Km north of the city center.

Transportation from/ to the airport is by metro or taxi:

Metro from airport

The Porto Metro system offers a quick connection between the airport, the city center and the main hotels in Porto, with services every 20 minutes. Line E (Violet) connects Airport Station to Estádio do Dragão Station, and, the whole metro network.

The service defined for Line E (Violet), Airport – Estádio do Dragão, assures a direct (without any overflow) and very fast link (travel time about 25 minutes) to the Porto city center. Purchase an Andante *Occasional* ticket to travel between the Airport Station and Porto city center (Zone 4). At the Andante shop located in the arrivals area of the Airport, you can also buy the *Andante Tour*, an unlimited and intermodal ticket valid for 1 or 3 days.

Cost: Zone 4 Ticket - 1.85 € one way. - Last Connection at 0h35

Taxi from airport

A taxi to the center costs approximately 25 €

Note: Taxis charge an additional 20% from 22.00 to 06.00. An additional surcharge of 1.50 € may also be applied for extra luggage, although wheelchairs and other equipment required by physically handicapped people are transported free of charge. The price is the same, regardless of the number of people sharing a taxi (maximum 4 per taxi).



Traveling to Porto

BY TRAIN

Journey time: 3 hours from Lisbon, 12-14 hours from Madrid. Departure point: From Lisbon: Santa Apolónia/Gare do Oriente.

Arrival point: Porto railway station Campanhã.

Cost: From Lisbon 42.40€ (1st class) and 30.30 € (2nd class) – Alfa Pendular

There are three international connections daily to Paris via Madrid and several trains daily to Lisbon. For more information please visit www.cp.pt

BY CAR

You can use highway "A28" between Vigo (Spain) and Porto, or highway "A1" between Lisbon and Porto. Both are good and new highways, and the "A1" has a toll fee (about 25€)

Traveling within Porto

CAR RENTAL AND PARKING

It costs approximately 90€ per day to rent a car. To rent a car you can contact SkyrosCongressos Phone: +351 22 616 54 50.

Street parking usually costs about 1€per hour in the city center.

TAXIS

The phone number of the taxi call center in Porto is +351 22 5073900. Taxi stands can be found at various locations in the city center. Almost all the conference hotels have a taxi stand located at a distance of no more than 150m. A taxi from the airport to the city center costs approximately 25€

MONEY

The local currency is the Euro (€). Banks in Portugal are open Monday-Friday, 08.30-15.00 (Banks at the airports are open 08.00-20.00). Portugal also has an extensive network of cash dispensers (ATMs) which operate 24 hours a day.



SHOPPING

The most traditional shopping area is Rua Santa Catarina, along with the narrow streets going up and down from the city center till Ribeira, by the Douro River side.

Several shopping centers, in Porto and around it, are open every day till 23.00. Besides the major international franchising and brands, national textiles, leather, pottery, shoes, crystal, wines and gold handcraft can be found in the shops.

VISAS

LOCAL TIME

The local time in Portugal is Greenwich Mean Time (GMT), the same as in London. During Western Europe Daylight/ Summer Time (WEST), the time is GMT + 1 Hour.

ELECTRICITY

Portugal uses a 220V system, sockets have the European standard and plugs are two-prong.

18h00 - 20h00 (Estimated End Time) CONCERT - FROM MOZART TO MAHLER - CASA DA MÚSICA ORQUESTRA SINFÓNICA DO PORTO

Olari Elts, Conductor Benjamin Schmid, Violin
Peter Eötvös Diálogo com Mozart W. A. Mozart, Violin Concerto No 4

Gustav Mahler Totenfeier Gustav Mahler, Symphony No10, Adagio

Unsurprisingly, Mozart's music conquered not just the audience but also generations of composers from all backgrounds. In a program that continues the Complete Violin Concerts, interpreted by the acclaimed Viennese violinist Benjamin Schmid, the tribute to the genius of Salzburg is explicit in a work by Peter Eötvös. Dialogue with Mozart is a transcription for orchestra of Da Capo, premiered by Remix Ensemble in 2014, that transforms fragments or ideas sketched by Mozart that did not result in finished compositions. Mahler was also an admirer of the celebrated composer, and as a conductor he was one of the people responsible for the inclusion of his operas in the center of the repertoire. The symphonic poem Totenfeier (Funeral Rites) was written in a very productive period but haunted by an impossible love. The premonition of death and the love triangles that shaped Mahler's moods also dominated the time when he began his 10th Symphony. The intensity of Mahler's feelings is reflected in the very intensity of the Adagio, but the final reconciliation planned for the end of the symphony was never accomplished.

20h30 Dinner at Serralves Restaurant in the Contemporary Art Museum

Serralves Restaurant is located in the museum building, with panoramic views over the park. The terrace with esplanade allows diners to enjoy the magnificent surrounding landscape!

TOUR DESCRIPTION

Porto is considered World Heritage by UNESCO since 1996 and it was also nominated the Best European Destination in 2014. Porto, the "Cidade Invicta" (unvanquished city) is history, architecture, culture, gastronomy, trade, encounters and discoveries.

This tour will show you Porto's main attractions. It will start from the conference venue, Sheraton Porto Hotel and take you down town passing by Boavista, "Palácio de Cristal" Gardens and some of the most important monuments in the city such as the Carmelitas Church, the Clérigos Tower and Church, which is one of the most symbolic monuments of the city of Porto. Nearby you will find Lello's Bookshop, which inspired J.K. Rowling's writing of the famous Harry Potter books. Followed by Aliados Avenue, with its granite buildings, many of which are crowned with skylights, domes and pinnacles. It is marked by City Hall at the top and a large central square, where statues come to life. Then we will take you to visit S. Bento train station with 20 000 tiles set in panels, representing transport evolution and important historical events such as wars and conquests. Afterwards, at the top, the magnificent Porto's Cathedral. Going down you will not miss Palácio da Bolsa and Ribeira at the riverside.

Six Bridges Cruise on Douro River in Typical "Rabelo" Boat (50 minutes)



Navigate through the river banks of Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia in a typical Rabelo Boat and discover the beauty of the Douro River. Enjoy and learn about the magnificent six bridges that unite these two cities! Relax while admiring the architecture of the bridges - Luís I, Infante, Dona Maria, S. João, Arrábida and Freixo - from the oldest to the most modern.

Observe the main points of interest that the view allows Ribeira Historic Area, S. Francisco Church, Stock Exchange Palace, Porto Customs House (Alfândega), Port Wine Museum, Massarelos Church, Arrábida Bridge, Foz do Douro, Afurada (Fishing Zone) and the mouth of the river, Crystal Palace, Electric Car Museum, Pier of Gaia, Port Wine Cellars, Monastery of Serra do Pilar.
