

NFI Policy for the Quality Assurance of Trainers Who Train under the Auspices of the NFI (Trainers in Transition)

Adopted, 13 February 2015

NIDCAP and APIB Trainers who are authorized to train under the auspices of the NIDCAP Federation International (NFI) as stipulated in the NFI Policy on NIDCAP and APIB Trainers in Transition (Adopted, 11 August 2014) are expected to follow the guidelines spelled out below:

1. Trainers, functioning under the NFI, issue NFI specified Training Certificates to their trainees upon completion of certification requirements.
2. The Chair of the NFI Program Committee serves as the proxy Training Center Director for Trainers in Transition. Trainers send to the Chair of the NFI Program Committee a list of the persons and hospitals, whom and where they train, and update the Chair of the NFI Program Committee regarding any changes, additions, completions, etc.
3. Trainers copy the Chair of the NFI Program Committee on all formal feedback and follow-up correspondence with their sites and trainees. Trainers in Transition may call on the Chair of the NFI Program Committee regarding any questions, conflicts, etc that may arise in the process of training.
