To raise public awareness on behalf of premature infants and their families around the world, the European Foundation for the Care of Newborn Infants (EFCNI) and partnering European parent organizations launched **World Prematurity Day** (WPD) in 2008. This international commemoration is recognized on November 17th each year and is growing in scale and strength. The NFI actively joined this effort in 2014. Activities to mark the day may include: local events, often hospital-based; town and city activities (such as bridge and building illuminations in purple, the color associated with WPD); and international level campaigns (such as EFCNI's WPD Toolkit and the NFI's *NIDCAP Care Around the World* poster).

In preparation for celebrations of this momentous day, Silke Mader (Chairwoman of the EFCNI and former NFI board member) and Mandy Daly (Member of the EFCNI Parent Advisory Board and current NFI board member) offer the following <u>Guidelines for Creating Positive and Respectful World Prematurity Day Celebrations</u>. They write that it is important "to find a sensitive balance between celebrating this day and respecting the needs of the infants in the NICU as well as their parents." Please heed the considerations offered as WPD plans are being made and implemented.



On this topic of **WPD 2017**, we invite you to participate with the NFI in celebrating premature infants and their families. The following ways to celebrate are offered:

- <u>World Prematurity Day 2017 Info Sheet</u> This informational sheet can be used to introduce WPD to your NICU or to be shared with your local government or local media outlets to gain broader exposure for your WPD events. - WPD NFI-EFCNI Poster Template The NFI, as a participant in the EFCNI's Socks for Life Campaign, has created a poster template for your use to advertise any activities you have planned to celebrate.
