Discussions included updating the organization's strategic plan, reviewing and projecting the NFI budget for the remainder of the 2016-2017 funding year, reviewing and finalizing 2016 membership survey findings and discussing and planning for the Program, Finance, Advancement and Governance committees/sub-committees and task forces. The following revisions of the NFI Vision and Mission statements were adopted on April 29th:

NIDCAP supports development, enhances strengths and minimizes stress for infants, family and staff who care for them. It is individualized and uses a relationship-based, family-integrated approach.

The NFI promotes the advancement of the philosophy and science of NIDCAP care and assures the quality of NIDCAP education, training and certification for professionals and hospital systems.
