Our <u>NFI Membership Meeting</u> was held on Wednesday, October 26th. Highlights of this meeting included brief summaries of the work and proposed next steps for the each of the NFI committees (Advancement, Governance, Program and Finance) as well as an overview of the President's Report. Two additional working groups were convened to describe and promote discussion regarding the findings from the Membership Survey (observations, comments and requests as reported by Kaye Spence) and the Trainers Meetings planning group (format and logistics as reported by Nikk Conneman). Elections were held for three board seats. During the period of the election vote count, members met in break-out groups to offer insight, suggestions and involvement on eight topics that ranged from *NIDCAP Beyond the NICU* to *Science* to

Membership. All of these discussions will be summarized in the Minutes of the Membership Meeting and will be posted on our website as soon as they are available. Your continued input and participation is welcomed. The Membership expressed our profound gratitude to gretchen Lawhon (stepping down as our organization's president after four years though continuing to serve on the board) and Kathleen VandenBerg, PhD (stepping down as a member of the NFI Board of Directors) for their decades of instrumental contributions to NIDCAP and as founding members of the NIDCAP Federation International. Election results for new three year board terms included the reelections of Heidelise Als, PhD and Nikk Conneman, MD and the addition of Björn Westrup, MD, PhD (who had previously served on the NFI board from 2001 to 2007).

One of the clear requests from trainers and professional members alike identified in the Membership Survey, and our first action item, is for the development of additional educational materials to support understandings and implementations of NIDCAP. To create resources for our group, we ask you to consider filming examples of NIDCAP care (similar to the photographs that you have provided for our poster celebration of World Prematurity Day) and submitting them to Sandra Kosta (Sandra.Kosta@childrens.harvard.edu) for us to compile into training materials. Videos need to have permission for sharing and for educational use. Please contact Sandra and me with any technical questions you may have and to let us know that you are planning to contribute to this project. Thank you for your considerations of this request to help us build training resources for our group.

On Saturday, October 29th, we held our first **NFI Board Meeting** of the new fiscal year. During this meeting we held officer elections, discussed the role of the NFI Officer position of Secretary and the format of minutes, and reviewed the Membership and Annual Trainers Meetings. The Board discussed suggestions for next year's meetings and set board priorities and our calendar for the coming year.
