# **Elections and Appointments**

During the October 21<sup>st</sup> 2018 Membership Meeting, elections were held for three, three-year NFI board terms. Results included the elections of *Jean Powlesland, RN, MS, and Dalia Silberstein, RN, PhD* and also for *Mandy Daly, ACII, DLD,* who ran unopposed for her reappointment as a Family Representative Member. During the April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, Board of Directors Conference Call, *Jennifer Degl, M.S.* was unanimously appointed to serve as an NFI Board of Director's Family Representative. Her term is through October 2022.

The first NFI Board Meeting, of the new fiscal year, was held on Tuesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>. During this meeting, officer elections were held. Deborah Buehler, PhD (President) and Gloria McAnulty, PhD (Treasurer) were re-elected. Dorothy Vittner, PhD, RN was elected to serve as the Vice President. During the December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 Board Conference Call, Jean Powlesland, RN, MS, was approved as the NFI Secretary. During the March 4<sup>TH</sup> Board Conference Call, Gloria McAnulty announced that she was taking a medical leave of absence from her Treasurer responsibilities. Sandra Kosta was voted by the Board to the role of Assistant Treasurer of the Board of Directors for the remainder of the fiscal year. She will assume the Treasurer's responsibilities, as a non-voting member of the Board. The Executive Council is comprised of the Board's Officers (D. Buehler, D. Vittner, G. McAnulty, J. Powlesland, S. Kosta) as well as Jim Helm, PhD (former Vice President).

# Highlights from this first half of the fiscal year include:

- On Novermber 17<sup>th</sup>, the NFI celebrated World Prematurity Day. We marked the occasion with with our annual poster of NIDCAP care from around the world. We also shared our NFI World Prematurity Day Information Sheet and Template developed in collaboration with the European Foundation for the Care of Newborn Infants.
- In February, the Volume 12, No. 1 of the *Developmental Observer* abstract issue was published under the direction of the the New Senior Editor, Kaye Spence, AM.
- On March 20<sup>th</sup> and throughout the month, the NFI celebrated the first Annual World NIDCAP
  Day. Resources were developed, including a Toolkit with Fact Sheets available in 13 languages
  (English, Arabic, Danish, Farsi, German, Hebrew, Irish, Italian, Japanese, Norwegian, Portuguese,
  Spanish), a logo, Poster Template, Training Center map, cover pages for Facebook and Twitter,
  a press Release. A Guidelines for the Use of World NIDCAP Day Materials document was posted
  on the website. Throughout the month, we honored, celebrated and shared the work we do in

- support of hospitalized infants and their families. Regional and international expressions of NIDCAP were made, including through social media posts from our NFI members and supporters of the meaning of NIDCAP. Expressions of global celebrations have been posted on the World NIDCAP Day page of the nidcap.org.
- In April, the NIDCAP and Science Subcommittee, Co-Chaired by Ita Litamanovitz and Dalia Silberstein (with committee members: Linda Lacina, Jeff Alberts, Leonora Hendson, Dalal Abdelgadir, and Dorothy Vittner) reimagined their outreach to the NFI membership. Regular communications have begun, entitled R³: Research, Read and Review, with the sharing of research relevant to NIDCAP. Articles with summary reviews are made available through the Google Listserv and then posted on the nidcap.org website.
- Throughout the year, there have been a number of Board developments, including: Jean Powlesland, Dalia Silberstein, and Jennifer Degl joined the Board, Dorothy Vittner, PhD, RN was unanimously voted by the Board to serve as the Vice President/Officer, Jean Powlesland was appointed to serve as the Board's Secretary/Officer, James Helm agreed to continue to serve on the Executive Council and is actively seeking new Advancement and Governance Chairs to assume his responsibilities before the end of his extended Board term.

#### **NFI Staff and Consultants**

The NFI continues to maintain a small staff/consultant team to ensure the ongoing work efforts of the organization. Sandra Kosta serves as the *Executive Director of Administration and Finance*. This integral half time position supports all four committees of the Board: Program, Finance, Governance and Advancement. Rodd Hedlund, MEd serves in the half-time NIDCAP Nursery Program Director position. In January 2019, Kaye Spence, AM, took on the role of the *Senior Editor* of the *Developmental Observer*. Kaye will receive financial compensation to attend the 30<sup>th</sup> Annual NIDCAP Trainers Meeting in support of her responsibilities.

# **NFI Meetings and Conferences**

The NFI's 29th Annual NIDCAP Trainers Meeting, October 20-23, 2018, entitled Love and Bonding in the Newborn Unit, was hosted in Porto by The São João NIDCAP Training Center, Portugal. The meeting was greatly appreciated for its outstanding educational program as well as its opportunities for networking, mutual support and shared experiences of Porto. We are very grateful for the year-long dedication and skillful efforts of the NIDCAP Trainers Meeting Planning Committee, co-chaired by Nikk Conneman, MD and Jean Powlesland, MS, RN, the meeting hosts led by Hercília Guimarães, MD, PhD and Fátima Clemente, MD, and the finance and meeting logistics team of Gloria McAnulty, PhD and Sandra Kosta. Abstracts from NIDCAP-related and scientific presentations were included in the first edition of the 2019 Developmental Observer.

The NFI Membership Meeting was held on Sunday, October 21, 2018 at the Sheraton Porto Hotel Congress Center, Porto, Portugal. Brief presentations from the President and Program, Governance, Advancement including the Family Advisory, and Finance Committee Chairs were given. Reports from each of these committees are posted on the NFI web and include a review of activities from the past year. Notable highlights from the meeting included a review of the 2018 NFI Membership Survey, presented by Kaye Spence, AM, an overview of the Foundational Education Workgroup initiative,

including a call for video lecture submissions, by *Juzer Tyebkhan, MD*, and our tremendous gratitude to *gretchen Lawhon, PhD, RN, CBC, FAAN's* as she stepped down from the NFI Board of Directors after many years of service. During the meeting, elections were held for the two open Board of Director seats with Jean Powlesland and Dalia Silberstein securing the most NFI member votes. Also, *Mandy Daly, ACII, DLDU* an unopposed for her reappointment of a three-year term as a Family Representative Member of the Board and was elected by proclamation. It will be held on September 5-7, 2019 in Portsmouth, New Hampshire, USA. This meeting is being organized by the NFI Trainers Meeting Planning Committee (Co-Chairs Nikk Conneman and Jean Powlesland), the NFI Finance and Meeting Logistics Team (Led by Gloria McAnulty and Sandra Kosta), and the 2019 Host (Jim Helm, PhD). The third day of the conference will be an Open Day with participants interested in NIDCAP from outside of our training center group. This day is focused on *Gut Feeling:The Other Brain. Exploring the Connections of Microbiome, Stress and Infant Behavior.* Within the meeting, on Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, we will hold our *Annual NFI Membership Meeting* for NFI updates, Board of Director elections, recognition of accomplishments, and membership questions.

NFI Members are invited to discuss, and offer questions, comments, and/or suggestions to the members of the Board for any of the topics raised and to support the NFI's efforts.
