Our hearts and thoughts are with all the people affected by the fighting in the Ukraine. May peace and safety be restored soon for the children, families and all the people of the region.




Warm World NIDCAP Month Greetings,

The 2022 *Conference on Ultra-Early Intervention* will be a hybrid meeting hosted by the NIDCAP Centers at Karolinska and Lund-Malmö, Thursday, March 24th. The meeting is entitled *Epigenetic science and nurturing care for newborn infants*. The conference will have dual focuses. The first half of the program will include "an historic reflection on NIDCAP in Sweden, and visions for NIDCAP for all hospitalized newborn infants and plans for the new NIDCAP Training and Research Center. The Lund-Malmö Center will be formally inaugurated and celebrated" during the conference. The second part of the program will focus on epigenetic science and nurturing care for newborn infants - an interesting field that could be valuable for NIDCAP research."
