


2021 Membership Meeting

September 20 & 22, 2021

- The NFI's End of Year Board of Directors Meeting was held over two four-hour virtual meetings.
- Governance Committee: J. Powlesland and D.
 Silberstein presented an overview of the
 committee's End of Year Report. The Board
 discussed ways to increase the number of
 members. Succession planning for Officers and
 Committee Chairs will be prioritized over the
 coming year.
- Advancement Committee: D. Buehler and J. Degl presented the highlights of the committee's activities. These include fundraising and various outreach efforts such as the newly developed NFI webinars, podcasts, and family resource videos.
- Program Committee: D. Vittner presented the committee's End of Year Report. For details of the many activities of the Program Committee, please see the report posted on the Membership page of the nidcap.org website. The Board of Directors voted to approve Nikk Conneman, MD as a Master

NIDCAP Trainer; Bieke Bollen, PhD as a NIDCAP Trainer; and the establishment of the NIDCAP Training Center at the University Hospitals Leuven, Belgium.

- Finance Committee: On behalf of the committee,
 G. McAnulty presented the End of Year Financial
 Report for FY2020-2021 as of September 15, 2021.
 The final report that will reflect the financial
 activity through the end of year on September
 30th, 2021. This report will be presented and
 approved at the October 13th Board Meeting. The
 Board favorably discussed hiring an eight hour a
 week assistant to help with specific administrative
 tasks.
- NIDCAP Trainers Meeting: The Board reviewed plans for the upcoming virtual meeting. The Board voted to post individual session videos from the NIDCAP Trainers Meeting within two weeks after the meeting and offer free access to registrants until the end of 2021.

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THE NFI CELEBRATES 20 YEARS!

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wenty years ago, the NIDCAP Federation International (NFI) was founded. In the years leading up to 2001, NIDCAP outreach had grown to 12 NIDCAP Training Centers (11 in the US and 1 in Europe). It became clear that NIDCAP efforts would be best served by organizing and forming a community of NIDCAP Trainers and supporters. So, in October 2001, the NFI was incorporated as a membership and educational certifying non-profit organization (501c3). Twenty years later, in 2021, our international community has grown to include over 3,000 clinicians, educators, researchers, families and students. The NFI continues to evolve, and to oversee, develop and support the NIDCAP model, caregiving and training approach.

The NFI's efforts, overseen by the Board of Directors, are distributed across four major committees: Program, Governance, Advancement and Finance, and three Advisory Councils.
