

# NFI Membership Updates and News from the President

**November 2022** 

#### Dear NFI Community,

Nearly three years in the planning, our 33rd annual NIDCAP Trainers Meeting, hosted by the warm, gracious NIDCAP Germany, Training Center Tübingen, happened! We met in a new hybrid way: in person, in beautiful Bad Boll, Germany, and virtually from places around the world. Our connections with one another and with NIDCAP felt especially strong after two years of only virtual meetings and the timing of this meeting so soon after the loss of our NFI Founder and friend, Heidelise Als, PhD.

Over the three days, there were 95 participants together in Germany and another 55 that joined us online. On the first day, we held an open conference with approximately 208 participants (in-person and online). Our meeting, dedicated to Heidi, was particularly meaningful as we honored her remarkable life, her incredible work, her rich, enduring relationships and our remembrances of her. We celebrated NIDCAP, NIDCAP Training Center and NFI accomplishments and one another. We were inspired with new insights, directions and connections. For the in-person participants, we explored the beautiful German countryside and gardens of Bad Boll and the enchanting city of Tübingen. After a couple of years of imagining being together (and being together in Germany!), enormous gratitude was felt for the opportunity to be part of this year's meeting.



In her seminal paper, Heidi wrote: Stimulation if appropriately timed or appropriate in quality and intensity will cause the organism to seek it out and move towards it, while maintaining a balanced level. (1982. Toward a Synactive Theory of Developmental: Promise for the Assessment and Support of Infant Individuality. Infant Mental Health Journal. 3, pp. 238-239) Being together, honoring and celebrating Heidi, being hosted by the German NIDCAP team, seemed just right for the NFI this year. As we seek to "rebalance" ourselves after the loss of Heidi, we will continue, with a renewed dedication, to work toward realizing the NFI and NIDCAPs potential to change the future for infants and families around the world.



# NFI Members Present on Immediate Kangaroo Care

On October 27, Björn Westrup, MD and Stina Klemming, MD presented Grand Rounds, simulation sessions and small group discussions at UCSF (California USA) on the *Immediate Kangaroo Care to Improve Survival of Low Birth Weight Infants: A Town Hall of International Experts.* This was one of four global events hosted by the American Academy of Pediatrics and Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. Björn and Stina's presentations were very inspiring and reassuring for the attendees from UCSF and across the Bay Area to consider how to successfully implement immediate skin to skin practices.



#### **NFI Board and Officers**

The NFI held its Board of Directors election this year through an online voting system for NFI Members in Good Standing. Results were announced at the 2022 NFI Membership Meeting. The two incumbent Board members, Fatima Clemente, MD (Open Seat) and Jennifer Degl, MS (Family Seat), were re-elected to serve on the Board. Charlotte Tscherning, MD, PhD was elected to fill the second open seat. Welcome Charlotte! Tremendous appreciation is expressed to Maria López Maestro, MD for her three years of Board service.

Over the past year, the Board of Directors have been updating the NFI's strategic plan. We received consultation from Mary Hiland, PhD to consider restructuring the make-up of our Board and our committees. Due to these potential substantial changes, as well as the recent death of our founder, the Board determined that continuity from the Board's leadership would best support upcoming transitions. I have just served six consecutive one year terms, which was the maximum number of years. An NFI By-Law revision was made to eliminate the maximum number of one year terms that the President and Vice President may serve.

Just after the NIDCAP Trainers Meeting ended, the Board met for its first meeting of the three month interim fiscal year (prior to the start in 2023 when the fiscal year will coincide with the calendar year). After welcoming the new Board, Officer elections were held and the slate of officers from the previous year was motioned. With no additional nominations to consider, the officers were re-elected for a one year term. The Board of Directors and Officers for the upcoming year are:

- The Board informally reviewed the 33rd Annual NIDCAP Trainers Meeting.
